Programme Details:

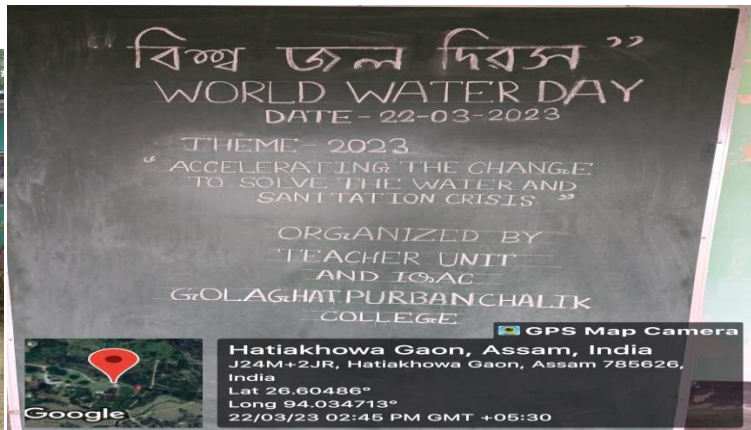

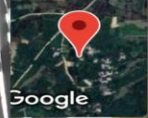
7. 12/05/2023 INTERNATIONAL NURSES DAY:

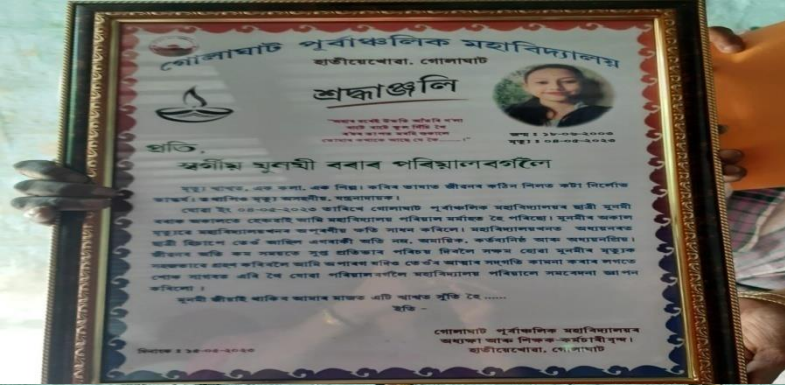


7. 22/05/2023, STUDENT MUNMI BORAH MEMORIAL HONOUR;

8. 05/06/2023 WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY/ 2023

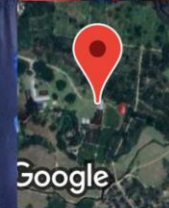

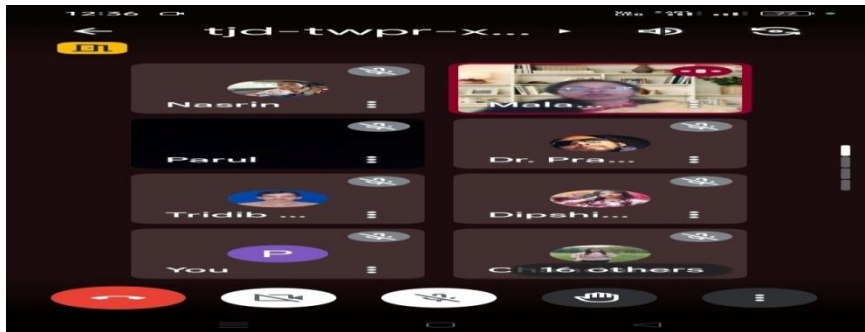
